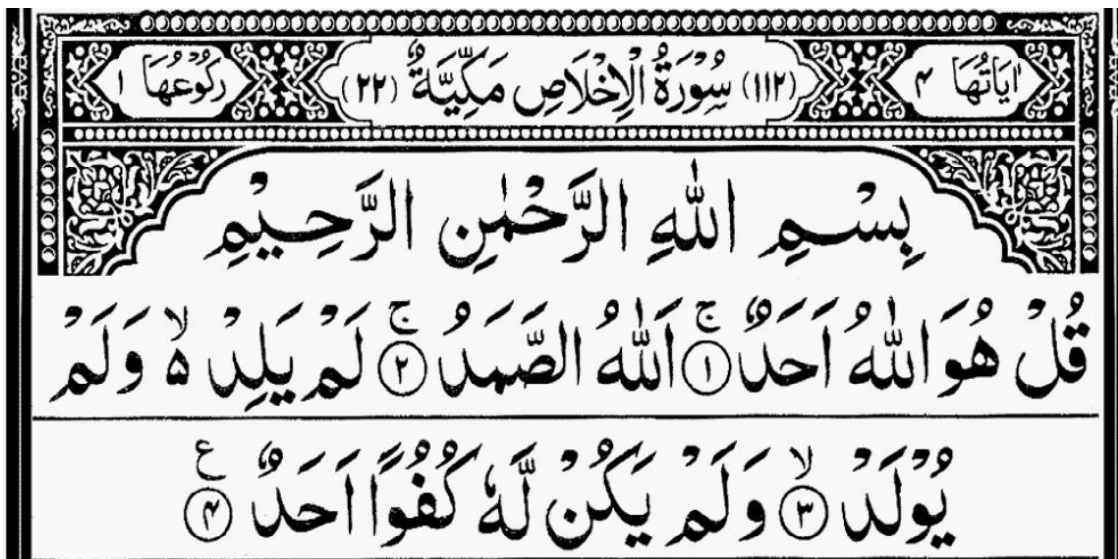
Sura Al-Kawthar (Sura #108, Juz # 30, Aya # 3)

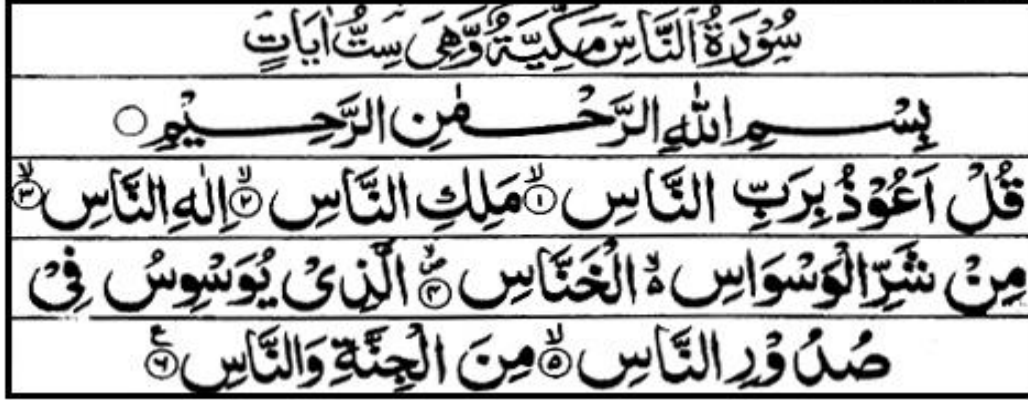


Sura Al-Ikhlās (Sura #112, Juz # 30, Aya # 4)

Say, 'He is Allah, the One. (1) Allah is the All-embracing. (2) He neither begat, nor was begotten, (3) nor has He any equal.' (4)

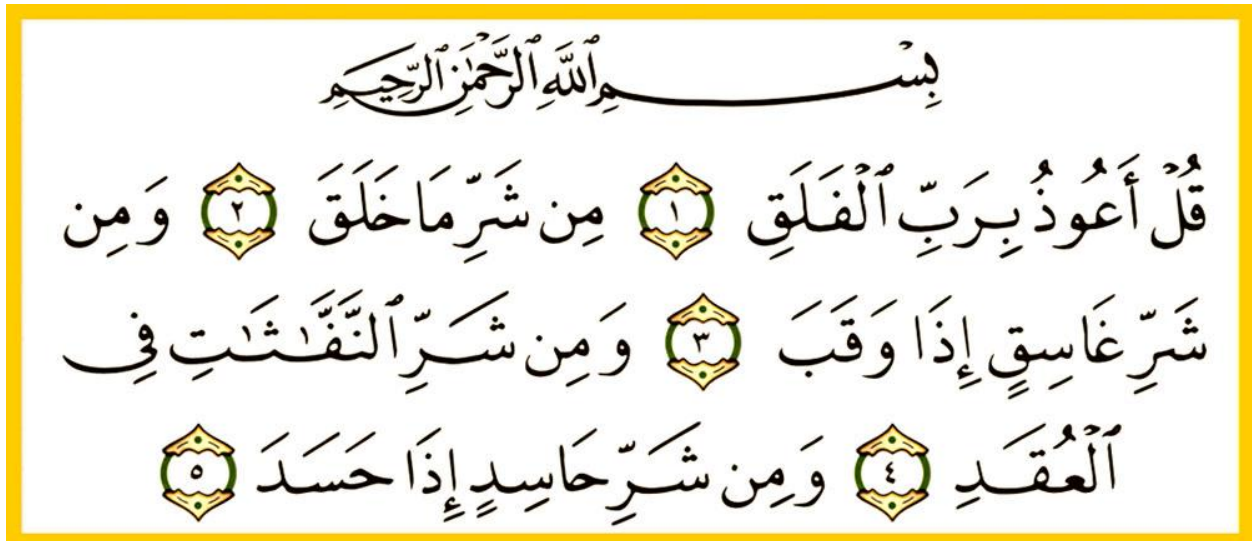

In the Name of Allah, the All-beneficent, the All-merciful.

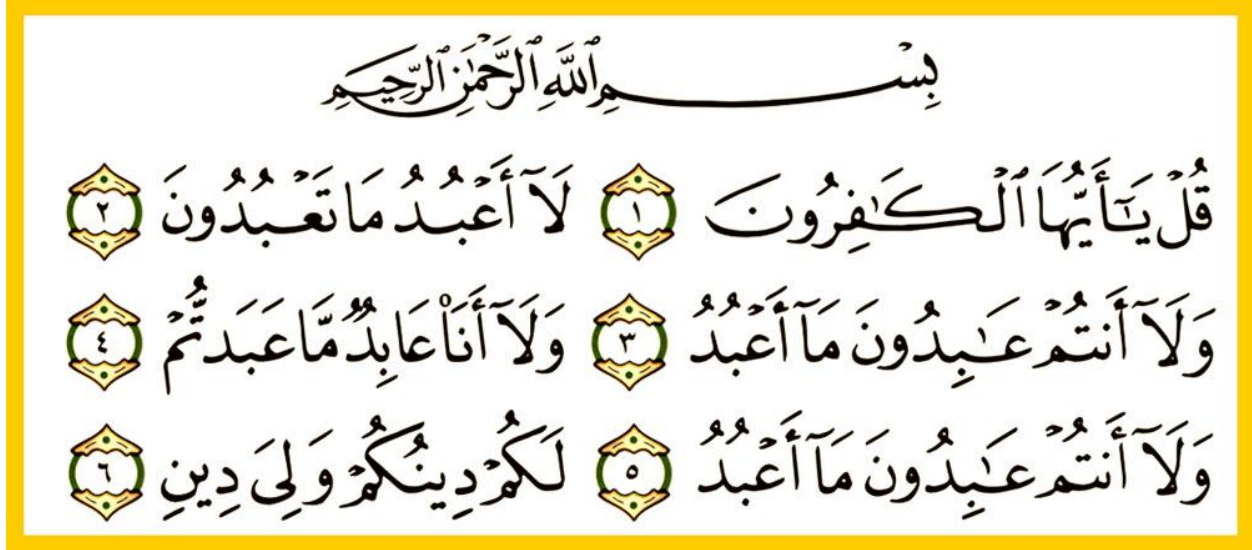

In the Name of Allah, the All-beneficent, the All-merciful.

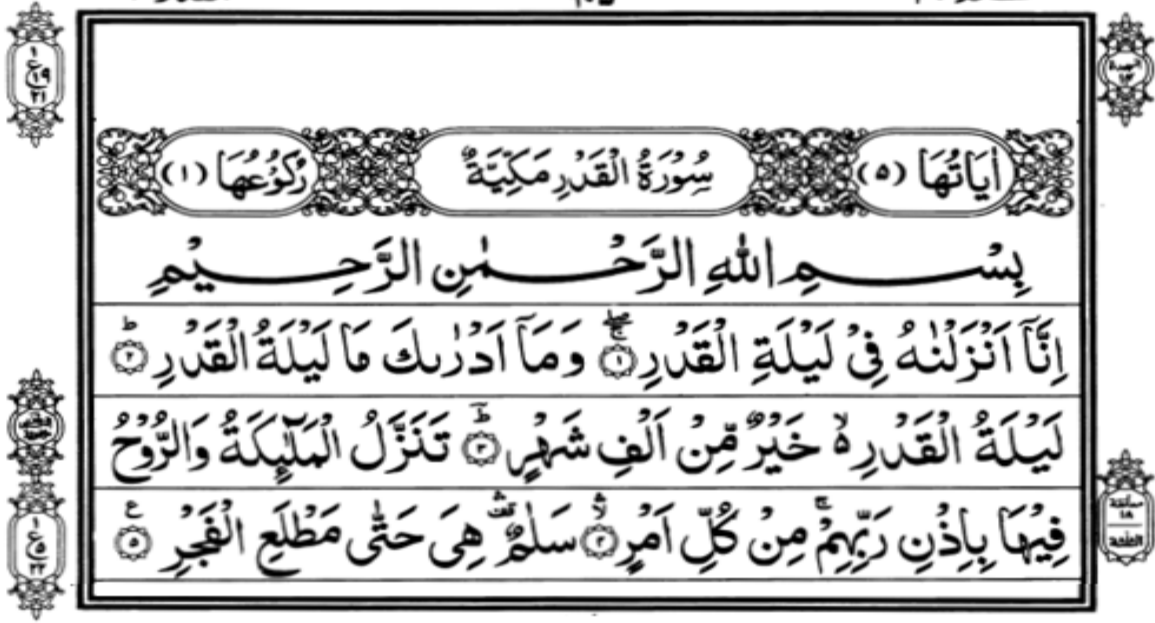
